Business Bingo Rules

Kimball Area Tourism has partnered with area businesses to promote shopping locally! During this difficult time, we want to be able to do what we can to keep our local businesses open.

Work to get a 'blackout' on the bingo card and you will be entered to win a \$100 gift certificate from Kimball Area Tourism to be spent at any of the participating businesses. To mark off a space, you need to make a purchase – either in the business if they are currently open, or online or over the phone if they are closed due to COVID-19. Some of the businesses are willing to do free quotes or consultations rather than purchases, so you can ask the business what they have to offer. You will need to have a recent receipt (within the last two months) or a signed note from each business verifying that you visited with them, to be qualified to win.

Once you have completed a blackout, call, text, or email Jessica Rocha, Tourism Director, and you will be entered to win the gift certificate. This is to help our local businesses stay open, so please do what you can to help out!

This will run from April 23, 2020 – May 31, 2020. Please have your bingo cards turned in to Jessica no later than noon on June 1st to be entered to win the gift certificate.
