The Maple 50 team with AmeriCorps NCCC has continued to amaze us with the amount of work they can accomplish!

They finished working with the South Platte Natural Resources District at Oliver Reservoir in the middle of August. While there, they were able to scrape and paint picnic tables, restrooms, and shelter houses, as well install a drip system on trees, make tree surrounds for next year's planting season, clean up trash, and remove invasive trees and weeds.






The team began working at the Visitor Center on the 17th. They built brochure storage racks, wood burned designs on picnic tables, prepped boards for a new billboard, built old west storefronts, pulled weeds, and painted murals on four walls of the building! The difference that all of this has made, and will make in the future, is incredible.

On the 21st, they took a day to help out at the Community Walking Trail. They put gravel in the entry area of the dog park, poured cement pads for memorial

benches, cleaned up trash, pulled weeds, and took out a few dead trees.



Work began with the Plains Historical Society at the musuem (old high school location) on the 31st. The team will work cleaning up rooms in the school to be prepped for displays. They will also spend some time prepping the Fraternal Hall downtown for Farmer's Day weekend, September 25th- 27^{th} .

There has been such an outpouring of kindness to make them feel welcome here and I can't express how much that means to me. Our community is amazing!!!
